"Unfortunately we don't live in mansions," she said. "People always seem to think that carnivals make a ton of money, but after you take into consideration the costs of hiring people, or moving and maintaining all of the equipment – there isn't that much left over."

In a prior interview Gillette Carnival Owner Betty Gillette said while owning the carnival has been challenging, it is a rewarding experience that has brought together family members for generations.

"Now that I've gath-

ered a decent amount of equipment, I'm pretty confident I'll be doing this for the rest of my life," said Betty Gillette.

She said it makes her happy to know people of all ages can come to the Otsego County Fair and enjoy her carnival, and she looks forward to attending it for years to come.

NORWICH – The youngest team in the 61stAnnual Canasawacta Country Club tournament field captured the Masters Flight after shooting back-to-back 7-under-par rounds to lead heading into the final round Saturday afternoon.

Club member Ryan Johnson and guest Nick Barney, teammates at LeMoyne College, went into the final 18-holes of the tournament with a five stroke lead over second place teams Bryan Smith-Brian Loomis and Matt Burrell-Craig Dawson.

As long as the duo didn't have a horrible round, their chances after Friday's second round were pretty strong after repeating their performance from Thursday's opening round, shooting a 64 both days.

Tim Carson, Canasawacta Country Club General Manager and tournament participant said while it was not the lowest round the course has witnessed in the member-guest weekend, it is the lowest the tournament has seen in quite some time.

The lowest round scored during the tournament was a 63.

Johnson and Barney started Friday's round out just like they did the day before, up and down. Johnson's shot on hole number nine was over the green and into the woods on the back side but Barney was able to put the score on the card for them at a birdie.

Their playing partners, Jeff Johnson and Denny Mirabito said during the round, the duo were playing well but they needed to string together something in order to come close to what they shot Thursday morning.

Well they did just that. The two scored seven birdies and two eagles during the second round to record the 7-under 64, giving them a total of 128 (14-under) with one round remain-

Hotel taxes one step closer to Chenango County

NORWICH - With a proposed measure recently passed by both houses of the state legislature, Chenango County lawmakers are one step closer to imposing an additional tax on hotel rooms across the county.

Members of the County Board Supervisors contentiously adopted a resolution in February requesting New York State approval of home rule legislation that would enact the local tax. If signed by the governor, the proposal would mandate a fee

Shawn Magrath of up to 4 percent on hotel, motel and bed and breakfast rooms county-wide.

> **Supporters** say money collected from the labeled "bed tax" may provide some relief to property taxpayers, and having it gleaned from out-of-towners would pay most - if not all - fees that the county currently pays to Commerce Chenango to promote local tourism.

> According to the Chenango County Treasurer's Office, average costs of hotel and motel rooms is roughly \$70 per night (potentially higher depending on time of year and

The proposal was introduced to the New York State Senate and Assembly in March by local assemblyman Clifford Crouch and Senator James Seward. In June, county officials were notified by Crouch that the proposal passed both legislative bodies and is now waiting to be signed by the governor. Once signed, the county would then be required

more input from the to hold a public hearing to adopt the proposal as a local law.

> "My office usually gets notification from the governor's office once he has signed the legislation into law," Crouch wrote in a letter to the Chenango County Board of Supervisors. "I will then follow up with you and inform you of such enactment. I, along with Senator Seward, am pleased that we could assist in this vital matter."

> County officials believe a tax, if approved by the governor, won't be put into effect until 2020.

Local Wetlands: A Unique Ecology

A few decades ago the term "wetland" did not exist. Instead Susquehanna those and Unadilla river land areas saturated with water were called marshes, swamps, fens, bogs, or even meadows. Today wetlands is a distinct ecological term and represents a distinct and unique ecosystem. The primary factor that distinguishes wetlands from other land or water bodies are the characteristic vegetation of aquatic plants. specially adapted to the unique hydric soil

So, what are wetlands any why are they

A wetland is a land area that is saturated with water, either permanently or seasonally, such that it takes on the characteristics of a distinct ecosystem. The primary factor that distinguishes wetlands from other land forms or water bodies is the characteristic and unique vegetation of aquatic plants, adapted to the specialized hydric soil. Wetlands play a number of roles in the environment, principally water purification, flood control, carbon sink and shoreline stability. Wetlands

are also considered the MOST biologically diverse of all ecosystems, serving as home to a wide range of plant and animal life.

Wetlands occur naturally on every continent except Antarctica the largest including the Amazon River basin, the West Siberian Plain, and the Pantanal in South America. The water found in wetlands can be freshwater, brackish, or saltwater. The main wetland types include swamps, marshes, bogs, and fens, and sub-types include mangrove, carr, pocosin, and varzea.

Wetlands are commonly found in the Susquehanna River basin and locally in the Unadilla River and Wharton Creek. Prominent wetlands are located south of New Berlin at the old Riverband Golf Course west of NYS 8. The naturally occurring wetland has been purchased by The Wetland Trust a privately owned corporation. The Trust is a 501(C)3 nonprofit corporation organized in 2008 to restore, conserve and protect wetland biota, functions and values. The Trust's Board Members represents academia, local government, local land owners, regional planners, and a multitude of partners, dedicated to enhance wetland-related efforts In 2017 the Trust owned and operated over 1,400 acres and protectst property in eleven counties in New York.

Another wetland less visible to local conservationists the Wharton Creek swamp located behind Hoboken Dam one mile east of New Berlin on NYS 80. The swamp is bisected by the former UVRR railroad bed between New Berlin and Edmeston. The swamp is privately owned and the railroad bed is abandoned but now serves as the William Quinn Beardslee Memorial Conservation Trail. The privately owned trail is approximately 3000 feet long and affords hikers a combination of forest, wetland, and dryland ecosystems.

Why Are Wetlands Valuable?

For many years, people did not recognize the many diverse benefits and values of wetlands. Consequently, New York has lost almost half of its historic wetlands to such activities as filling and draining. However, wetlands are

valuable to the people and environment of New York State. Some of the functions and benefits that wetlands perform include:

Flood and Storm Water Control

Wetlands provide critical flood and stormwater control functions. They absorb, store, and slow down the movement of rain and melt water, minimizing flooding and stabilizing water flow.

Surface and Groundwater Protection

Wetlands often serve as groundwater discharge sites; maintaining base flow in streams and rivers; and supporting ponds and lakes. In some places, wetlands are very important in recharging groundwater supplies.

Erosion Control

Wetlands slow water velocity and filter sediments, protecting streams, lakes, reservoirs and navigational channels.

Pollution Treatment and Nutrient Cycling

Wetlands cleanse water by filtering out natural and many manmade pollutants, which are then broken down or immobilized. In wetlands, organic materials are also broken down and recycled back into the environment, where they support the food chain.

Fish and Wildlife Habitat.

Wetlands are one of the most productive habitats for feeding, nesting, spawning, resting and cover for fish and wildlife, including many rare and endangered species.

Public Enjoyment

Wetlands provide areas for recreation, education and research. They also provide valuable open space, especially in developing areas whee they may be the ony green space remaining







Big name in Christian music to take the stage at Chenango County Fair

NORWICH – A big name in contemporary Christian music will take the spotlight at the Chenango County fairgrounds this year, bringing with it a mix of uplifting worship and alternative rock to the local stage.

Calvary Baptist Church and CV Free Church in Norwich have teamed up to add the Christian performing group Sidewalk Prophets to the 2019 Chenango County Fair concert lineup. The band will perform at 7 p.m. Friday, Aug. 9. Event organizers it's is a chance to give a positive experience to concertgoers while sharing Godly encouragement.

"Because we live in a rural area, people looking to enjoy Christian music and live concerts typically have to drive quite a distance to attend any of these events," said event co-organizer Tina Lindridge. "Since [Sidewalk Prophets] are a bigger name in the music business, we expect their gifts and talents, their knowledge and experiences to lend a positive experience for all who attend."

Sidewalk Prophets have steadily gained traction in the Christian music scene since releasing their first independent album in 2003. In 2007, the group scored a hit with the release of "These Simple Truths" which featured the song "The Words I Would Say." The album was lauded in the Christian music industry and led to the the band's nod for a 2010 GMA Dove Award for New Artist of the Year.

The group continued success with the 2012 album release of "Live Like That," and more recently "Something Different" in 2015.

In all, Sidewalk Prophet touts five No. 1 hits and eight topfive songs, including "You Love Me Anyway," "Help Me Find It," and "Live Like That."

"This is an awesome experience and opportunity for our community to hear the word of God and have a concert here of this magnitude," said event co-organizer Jim Potter. "We're hoping for a big turnout. Ticket sales are going well. Ideally we would like to fill the place."

The upcoming concert marks a first for Christian Baptist and CV Free churches which have each previously worked alone to bring Christian music to the Norwich area. In past years, Christian Baptist has attracted headliners including Unspoken and Finding Favour.

But the opportunity to work side-by-side creates a new dynamic, says Lindridge.

"In the past, the goal of hosting Christian concerts was to reach people's hearts with the encouragement that comes from Christian music," she said. "The Bible emphasizes the importance of spending time with other Christians and surrounding ourselves with people that can provide Godly advice, that help keep us in check, encourage and love us

... By having churches work together on this concert, we are building those connections and support systems that God wants for us. The bond of churches growing together is far stronger than each of our churches standing alone."
